Welcome to our October FSP Meeting. Thank you for coming out this morning and supporting us.

The check from our spring dine and donate at Panda Express recently came in. The check was lost in the mail. We profited \$171.74. Our next dine and donate will be at Panera in Frankfort on Tuesday, October 22nd. This event will run all day. Just let them know you are with District 157 FSP, so that a portion of the proceeds will come back to the FSP. Thank you for supporting us.

This year we had to move a few classes around, because we tried to get every class in to shop before Family Night. The bookfair will remain open on Friday for anyone who did not get a chance to shop during the week.

Please come out to visit us on Family Night. Grand Prairie is hosting a community night event from 5:30pm -7:30pm Tony Villa Rosa will be there serving pizza and snacks. Family Night is open to all district families. We encourage all to come out for this fun event.

Grand Prairie will have their Smoothie Day on Friday.

The last day to order November hot lunch is October 15th. This is the same for all boosters.

The FSP will host hot lunch the week of October 14th. On the menu this week is our fan favorite, Breaded Chicken Sandwich.

Picture retake is set for October 21st, If you plan to volunteer at the schools, this would be a good time to get your picture taken for your volunteer ID badge.

Our largest source of income so far this year are hot lunch and smoothie sales:

-We had two hot lunches in September. So far, I've recorded sales of about \$44k and expenses at about \$25k, profiting \$19k already. As has been the case in past years, sales numbers include ALL purchases made for the entire school year, not just September lunch purchases.

-Smoothies, I've received about \$9k in income and paid out about \$5k to our vendor. Smoothie sales follow the same logic as lunches with regards to advanced purchases.

Other items to note:

-We paid annual dues to PTO insurance and quickbooks.

- -My School Bucks Fees have been paid, a result of hot lunch and smoothie sales.
- -We have paid \$1950 for a HC assembly, Attaboy.
- -Thank you to everyone who participated in our mums fundraiser. We did pay out \$2392.60 to Golden Gate Nursery. I am still waiting on the final sales report and bank statement to calculate income.
- -We spent \$164.69 for the prize wheel and prizes at Tiger Trot. It was a fun and popular event for the kids and we will continue to have the prize wheel at other FSP events.
- -We have also re-stocked GP and HC with snacks, water, and spoons for those students who might have forgotten lunch or spoon.
- -Last, but not least, we had two un-fundraiser donations. One for \$25 from Lauren Fuhr and one for \$50 from someone wishing to remain anonymous.
